**SchoolMessenger (student absence notification/messaging system)**

A few weeks ago the Molalla River School District enabled a new notification system, SchoolMessenger. If your child is absent and it is an unexcused absence, you will be notified with a phone call and an e-mail (if we have your phone number and e-mail on file with the school). We will also use the notification system to send messages from the school/school district. If you would like to limit notification to only a phone call, only an e-mail, or opt in to being notified through a text message, please go to: <https://go.schoolmessenger.com/#/account/login> and register. Once you register, you may choose how you want to receive the notifications; phone calls, texts, or e-mails. Note: you do not have to register; this just gives you the options of choosing how you are notified of absences and other messages. After registering, your phone number will show with a drop down arrow next to it – drop down to consent for your phone number to be used. After that, click on your name on the top right hand side of the page and drop down to preferences to choose how you want messages delivered. There are several message categories to choose from and you are able to choose how you want each of them delivered: Attendance Messages, Non-School Hours Emergency Messages, School Hour Emergency Messages, General Messages and Survey Messages. You may choose different notification methods for each of the message categories.
