- Go to www.flashalert.net
- Select the "View Local News" tab (far left tab)- drop down and select region (Portland/Vancouver/Salem)
- Double click on Clackamas Co. School hyperlink
- Double click on Molalla River School District hyperlink
- Enter email address
- Create personalized account
