- Clarkes Grange will award two grants up to \$2,000.00 each to be used in the
 academic year beginning in August or September immediately following award of the
 grant(s). Each grant is nonrenewable, but former recipients may reapply. The Award
 Selection Committee may, but is not required to, select one alternate to receive one
 of the two awards if a winner becomes disqualified.
- 2. Each grant is available to graduating high school seniors or any high school graduate wanting to go to college or trade school for further education, and who lives in, or has a permanent address in, the boundaries of the Clarkes-Highland CPO (web5.co.Clackamas.or.us/taxmap/), or who is a current member of Clarkes Grange.
- 3. Selection will be made by an Award Selection Committee, the members of which shall be independent of Clarkes Grange.
- 4. The selection shall be based on: A. Financial need; B. Involvement in community activities; C. Attendance at school or work; D. Completeness of application; and E. Personal character.
- 5. Applications must be received by the Clarkes Grange Ed. Chairman postmarked on or before the April 15th prior to the academic year for which the award will be given.
- 6. The recipient may attend any accredited institution of higher learning: University, Community College, Trade or Vocational School.
- 7. After we receive written verification that the recipient is enrolled in an appropriate school, the Clarkes Grange Treasurer will send a check to the Financial Aid Office in the student's name.
