## SUMMER SCHOOL

Dear Parents & Guardians,

Molalla High School is offering an online summer school program from **July 1-25, Monday-Thursday (excluding July 3 & 4)**.

### Why consider Summer School?

- Summer school is a low-pressure environment.
- Students earn high school credit for each class they successfully complete (up to three classes).
- It is a great opportunity for current students to recover credits missed during the school year.

### Who is eligible for Summer School?

- Students who received an “F” in a class at Molalla High School and/or are credit deficient (credit deficient is defined by the student not having the time to complete the appropriate amount of credits to graduate with their class).
- Any student outside of our district that meets the criteria.

### Summer School Details:

- 9:00-12:00 Monday-Thursday in the large computer lab (Room 202)
- 4-Week program (**July 1-25**) at Molalla High School
- On-site teacher to assist students in their studies.
- High School credit courses are \$100 per .5 credit course. Students may take up to 3 courses (1.5 credits).
- The program is funded by tuition only and therefore must have a minimum of 25 high school courses signed up and paid by **June 21st**. If this minimum is not met, summer school may be cancelled with parents receiving a full refund. No refunds will be given after **June 21st** if the program is available.
- Courses will show as a Pass/Fail on transcripts (On-line courses are not considered college preparation classes and will not count towards entrance requirements into 4-year university systems. See your counselor for more details if needed).
- Students do not need to attend all days of summer school, but an on-site teacher will be available for support on the days and times noted in this document. Students may also work on their e-school courses from home.

### How do you sign up for summer school?

- Fill out the Summer School Registration on the back of this form and get your Counselor’s signature.
- Make checks out to Molalla High School and pay Mrs. Lee-Hill or go to [www.schoolpay.com](http://www.schoolpay.com) and submit payment. Return the registration form and receipt of payment to your counselor by **June 21**.

### What about summer commitments and travel plans?

- Students may complete the online course assignments at a remote location or during office hours if arranged in advance. However, students must take all tests during office hours.

### Transportation

- Unfortunately, transportation is not provided. Students must find their own transportation to and from summer school.
